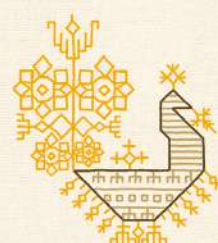
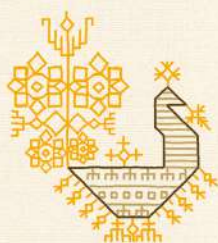
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INTRODUCTION

India, a nation of diverse landscapes, encompasses over 4,000 cities and 600,000 villages, each contributing to the country's dynamic character, weaving together a mosaic of regional crafts, traditions, and textiles across a rich fabric of socio-cultural plurality. The threads of this heritage intertwine in more than 500 handloom clusters, employing millions and preserving centuries-old techniques—a testament to not only artistic prowess but also a significant contributor to the national economy.

What does it mean to carry this legacy forward? How do we guard this rich identity while simultaneously forging a path for a fashion-forward India?

Today, India stands at the intersection of tradition and modernity, adeptly adapted to the evolving international landscape, while its consumers display a unique profile. Variations are manifest in every aspect, from the changing seasons to deeply ingrained values and aspirations. While the world at large has developed its own lexicon of fashion over time, none of the global agencies have successfully comprehended the intricacies of India's fashion dynamics or offered India-specific fashion forecasts with seasonal design direction, colour schemes, material exploration, or insights into potential business opportunities through new product lines.

It is high time to rekindle the grandeur of this ancient land, not only by manufacturing clothing for the world but also by articulating the evolving fashion desires of India's burgeoning and ever-evolving 1.4 billion citizens. The future of fashion consumption is upon us, and our contribution lies in bridging the gap between Indian sensibilities and international standards.

In 2017, the honorable Prime Minister envisioned a future for Indian fashion at the Global Textile Summit, addressing this gap and emphasizing our potential. One where we as a country engage in a dynamic dialogue, drawing inspiration from within while projecting our influence outward.

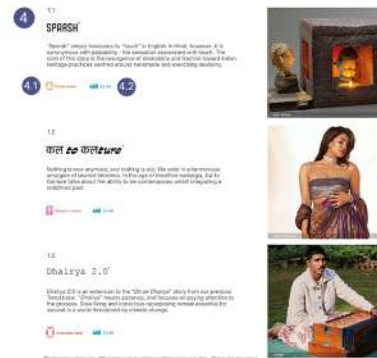

With 60+ micro trend reports, 6+ close-to-season trend reports, 3+ research papers, 2 e-magazine, 1 youth trend report, 1 emerging mindset book, and the first taxonomy of 75 Indian wear categories, this book will mark the first launch of a fashion trend forecast by VisioNxt.

The broad categories of intervention include the colour of thread, thread count, reed count, and motifs taken into consideration when recommending a textile.



How will this book benefit weavers, artisans & craftspeople?

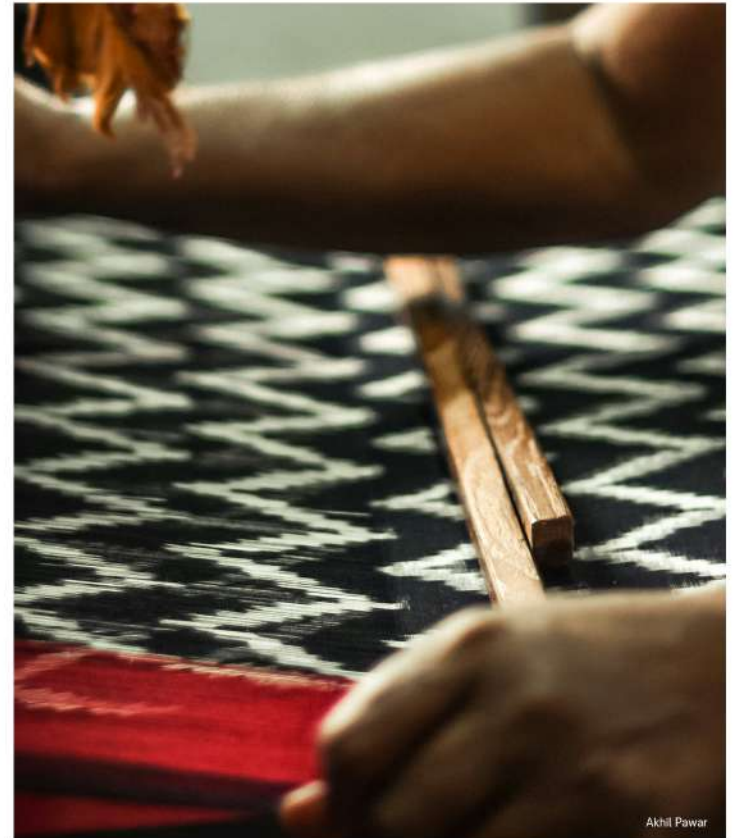
Deriving Design from Inspiration:

1. Begin by examining images and keywords within a given narrative. Identify key visual elements from a foundational perspective: Analyse lines, considering their nature (straight, curvilinear, squiggly).
2. Identify prominent shapes such as circles, squares, triangles, etc.
3. Evaluate texture, discerning between rough or soft, sheer or opaque.
4. Explore the emotional tone conveyed and its calming or evocative nature.
5. Note the suggestive and prominent colours.
6. Translate a chosen keyword into a visual representation:
7. Pose questions like, "What does [keyword] look like in the context of the craft?"

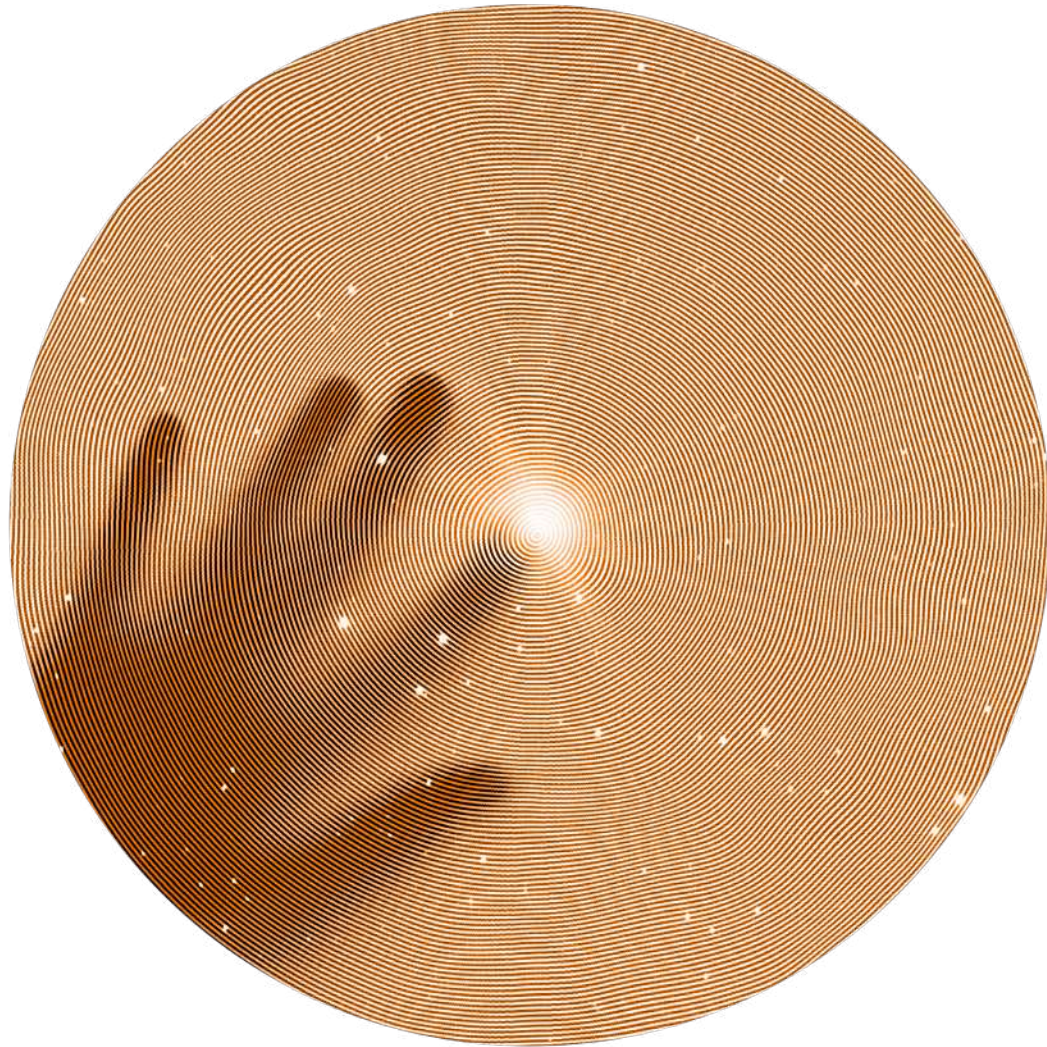
Once inspiration is thoroughly dissected, apply these design elements to the craft or weave:

1. Example: Envision a Single Ikat weave with chaotic, uneven lines.
2. Example: Imagine madras checks incorporated in the prominent colour scheme of the narrative.

This process is illustrated in this book through examples of craft, and textile practices coupled with our humble suggestions on how slight adaptations could significantly broaden the reach, applicability, and alignment with the evolving mindset and needs of the Indian consumer.

Why

PARIDHI ?

'Paridhi', a versatile Sanskrit term, encapsulates a plethora of meanings, each resonating with profound symbolism. While its literal translation refers to 'circumference,' Paridhi transcends mere boundaries. It evokes the expansive horizon, the ethereal halo around the sun, or even the boundless ocean encircling the Earth. Despite its connotations of enclosure and limitation, Paridhi beckons us to introspect within its limits and venture beyond its confines, eliciting both containment and expansion. The term embodies a circularity that defies a clear origin or conclusion, symbolising the timeless and cyclical essence of trends. Paridhi is about the infinite nature of finite elements.

The core of this Trendbook, Paridhi encourages exploration within and beyond its periphery, mirroring the endless possibilities of a horizon. The six sub-themes capture elements of being rooted which are not necessarily orthodox, of having faith not necessarily associated with religion. Within these themes, one finds the duality of thought and reflection, learning and unlearning. It champions not just the significance of expression but also the art of contemplation. 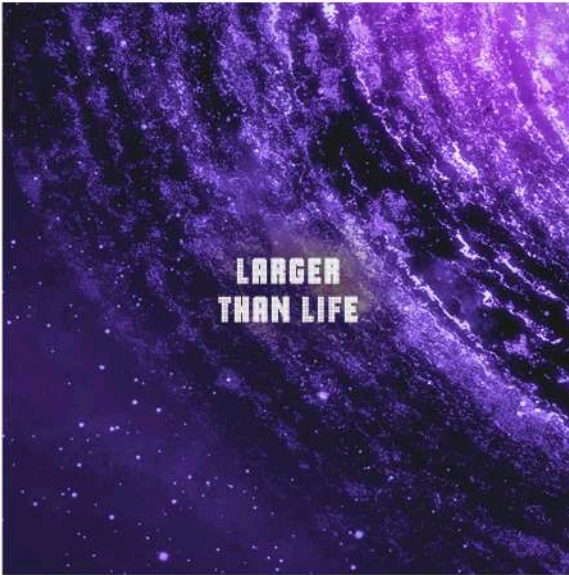
1. The profound and culturally rich Indian sentiment finds a tangible and tactile expression in **Maati Marabu**.

Furthermore, this compendium offers essential insights, such as weave and product inspiration, age cohorts and primary visual information derived from trendspotters in India. The product categories extend beyond apparel to include beauty and wellness products, lifestyle items, technical gear, sports equipment, technology, home goods, and furnishings. These resources are empowered by our state-of-the-art AI Deep Vision model which uses 70,000+ primary data along with 2,80,000+ secondary data. These are further analysed to make industry focused real time insights, rendering them indispensable for retailers, exporters, and independent designers.

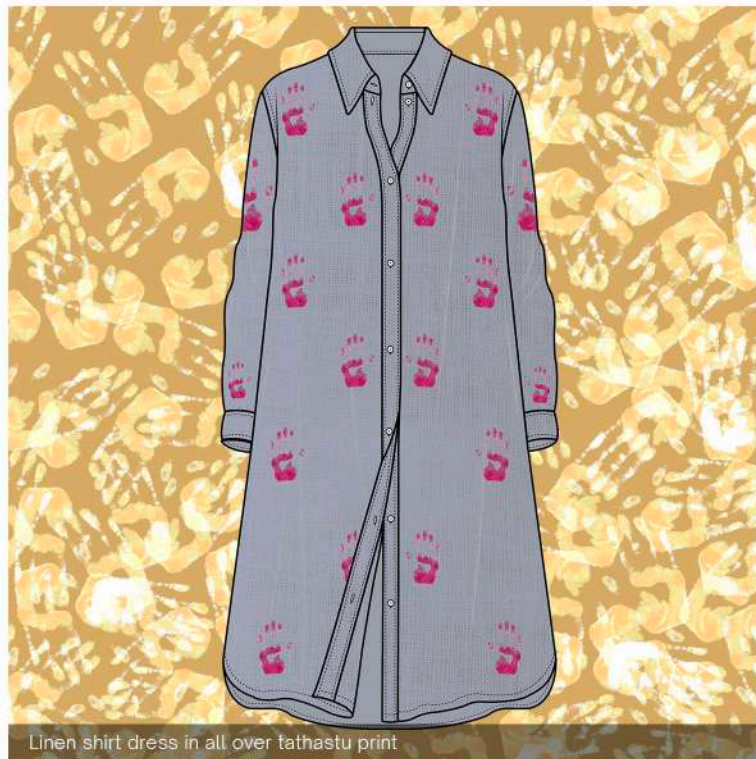
Tactility will take centre stage with a focus on **textured fabrics** and innovative fabric manipulation techniques.

Simpler and lighter silhouettes, featuring minimal embroidery and printed textiles in earthy and subtle colour palettes, will be endured for an extended period.

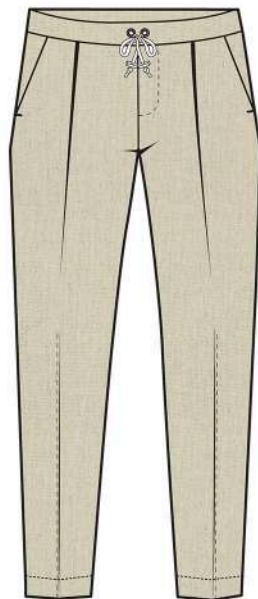
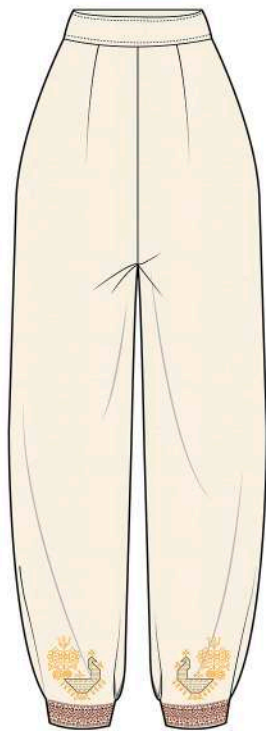
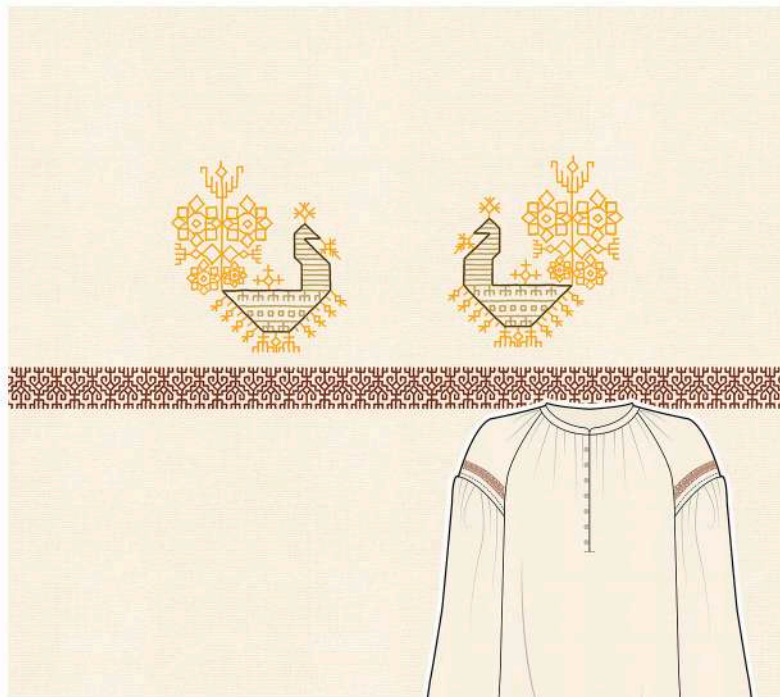

Directives for Weavers | Textiles

Utilising select images from the 'Maati Marabu' theme, here presented are a series of examples showcasing the practical application of insights derived from this book within the domain of textiles and weaving.



(Images 1 & 4) Textiles can achieve a smocked appearance through an open, distorted weft weave, creating a hypertextured effect crucial to our narrative.

(Image 6) Explore open weave structures with handspun or slub yarns.

(Image 2) Delve into intricate motifs using ornate brocades, including heritage florals (jaal) and strategically placed butas on vibrant fabric with suggestive colours.

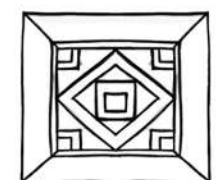
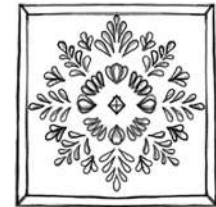
(Image 3 & 5) Incorporate elements from heritage objects, translating them into extra weft motifs. Keep the interpretation subtle and minimalistic to distinguish the added texture and colour of the motif from the fabric's base.

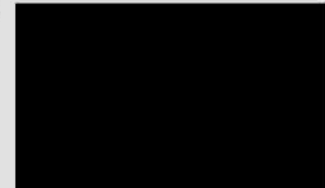
“In the last light of a long day, I sit on a chair on my porch and watch the sky drain colours down and out and I realise I want to hear my voice and only mine. Not the voice of my voice within a cacophony of old pains. Just mine, now.” - Jebby Slate, Little Weirds

Google defines darkness as the absence of light, a place where scant illumination exists. Such definitions draw clear lines of distinctions of positivity and negativity. However, despite the connotations that we ascribe to darkness it is just as vital as its counterpart. Light, too, has meaning only in context to darkness.

In its shroud, we may lose sight but gain ‘insight’ into the unknown and undiscovered. While it is very easy to be lost in the literalness of the dichotomy, the implication of this story is a psychological one. To deny darkness is to deny half of oneself. We can never completely mature unless we accept parts of ourselves that we sweep under the rug or keep in hiding. In confronting what lurks in the shadows of our inner lives and integrating it with our being, we actualize into dynamic individuals.

‘Dear Dark’ is a narrative centred around acceptance of the complete self. It is an unabashed and naked embrace of our soft underbellies. It is a protagonist, in that it materialises a chaotic journey into our inner world into a confrontation that shapes one’s unique voice. It is a call for authenticity. The parts that we are embarrassed about, the parts that we don’t show as often, the emotions that we don’t express are unearthed from darkness.

VisioNxt is the only trend insights research lab in India that obtains this data through a network of over **800+ trained trend spotters** spread across **16 cities** in India that capture not just the mood, spirit and 'everyday happenings' but also numerous emerging product details and DIYs through a unique ethical data aggregator mobile app. The VisioNxt spotters are trained using a distinct training module developed by us called '**TrendOrb**' which **stands on 6 pillars of learning, namely, - scan, capture, map, cluster, analyse and present**, in that very order respectively. This rigorous training process enables the trend spotters to see through a clutter of endless visual cues, and submit novel observations and findings. The continuous dialogue in our private social network channels ensure that we segregate 'hype' from 'directions' and map 'shifts' not only in fashion but also in the cultural and psychological space we operate in. **Big data and 'DeepVision'** allows us to process this enormous amount of information on a daily into specific ever-evolving dynamic trend clusters.

The core research laboratory of VisioNxt is nestled in Chennai. More than **40 academicians** and domain experts, **10+ key industry advisors** and **10+ dedicated core team members** cohesively map each emerging archetype as a collective zeitgeist and visualise the same in context to the fashion and retail industry. Every day, the team comes together to brainstorm and identify signals and directions for the emerging consumer landscape that incorporates **socio-cultural, technological, economic, environmental, as well as political elements** influencing sentiments and mindsets at large, to eventually deliver a consolidated industry-ready trend report.

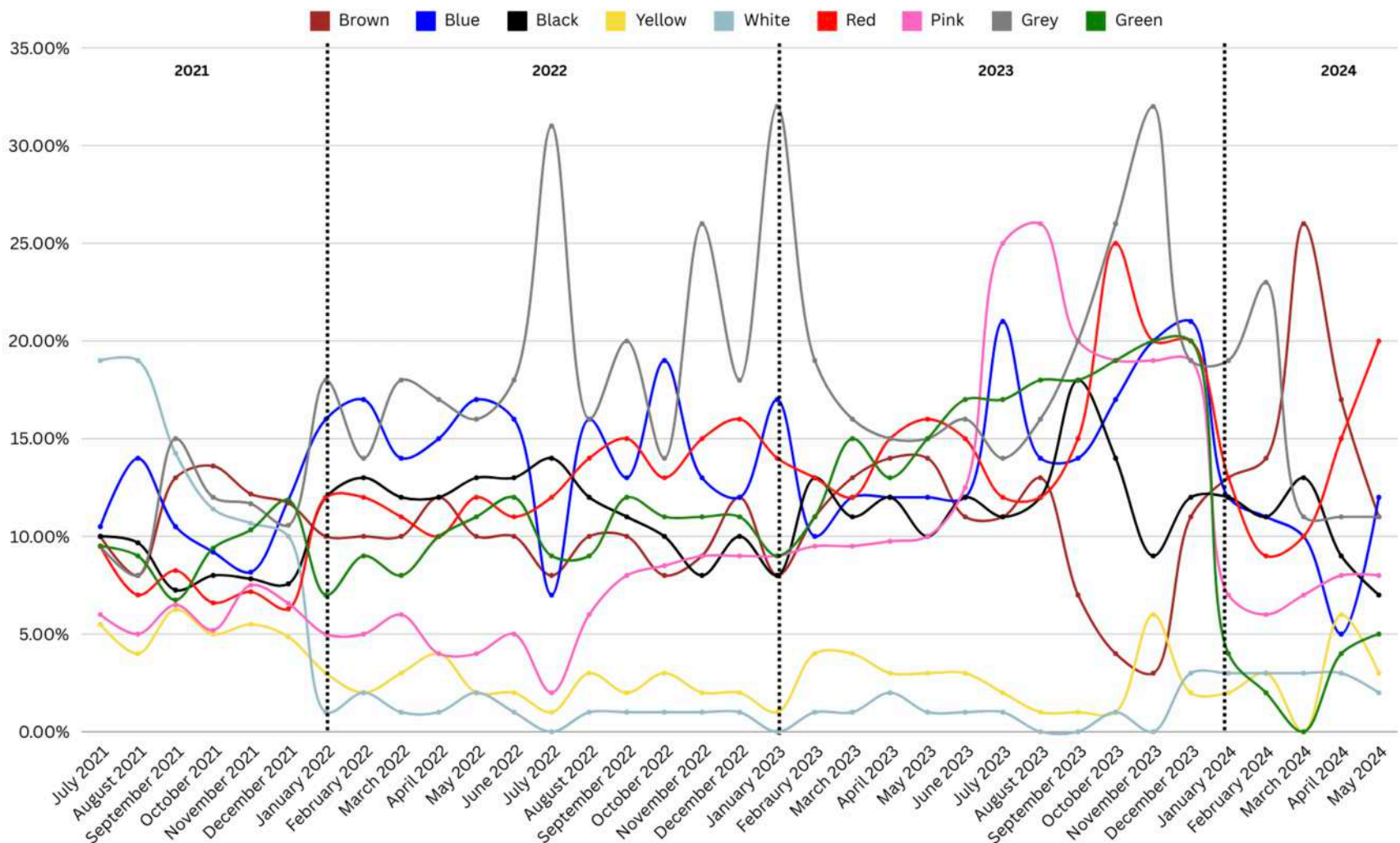
TREND EVOLUTION

With more than 2,80,000 data points, VisioNxt's (DeepVision) deep learning model is reliable and ethically approved. Over 800 trained Trendspotters - a select group of ambitious NIFT students- collect fashion signals, which are processed in this system. The deep learning model was developed to identify over 130 product categories. A unique taxonomy was specifically created to build such an elaborate model. The results thus obtained are further visualised as infographics and analysed by the Emotional Intelligence (EI) team. The analysis is rendered into industry-ready periodical reports: trendbooks, closer-to-season trend reports, micro-reports, mindset books, and blogs.

EVOLUTION OF COLOUR TREND (JUL'21 - MAY'24)

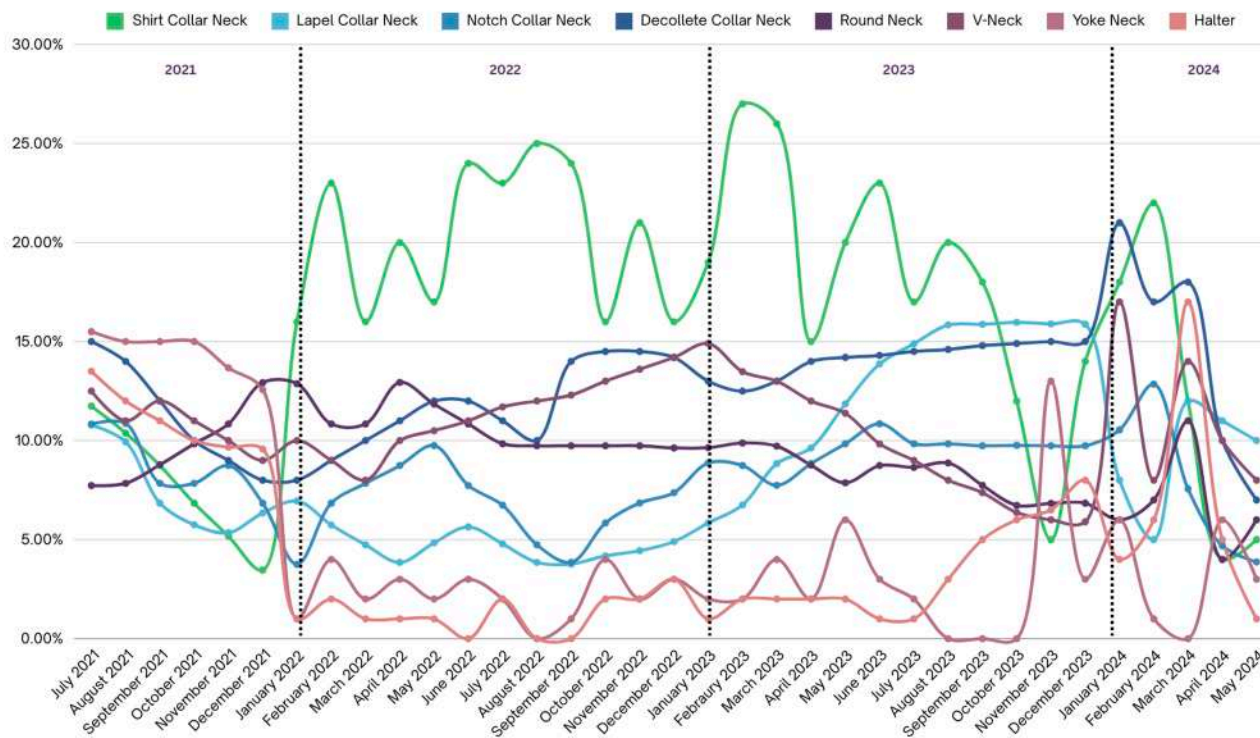
- The colour blue has stabilised over time, which is indicative of the omnipresence of denim. The rising demand is observed in entire apparel categories with a focus on said fabric.
- The colour yellow gained popularity in 2022 and gradually gained more prominence in 2023.
- The aggressive marketing campaign for Barbie subliminally impacted clothing choices months before its release. Post-release, the colour was unabashedly embraced and strong sentiments of affiliation were observed.
- Red has a cyclical resurgence during the latter half of every year. This owes to the major role the colour plays in festivities across cultures.



EVOLUTION OF NECKLINES OVER TIME (JUL'21 - MAY'24)

Collars have gained prominence which owes to the rising popularity of power dressing. This is also in alignment with the preference of tailored fits and the look of androgyny.

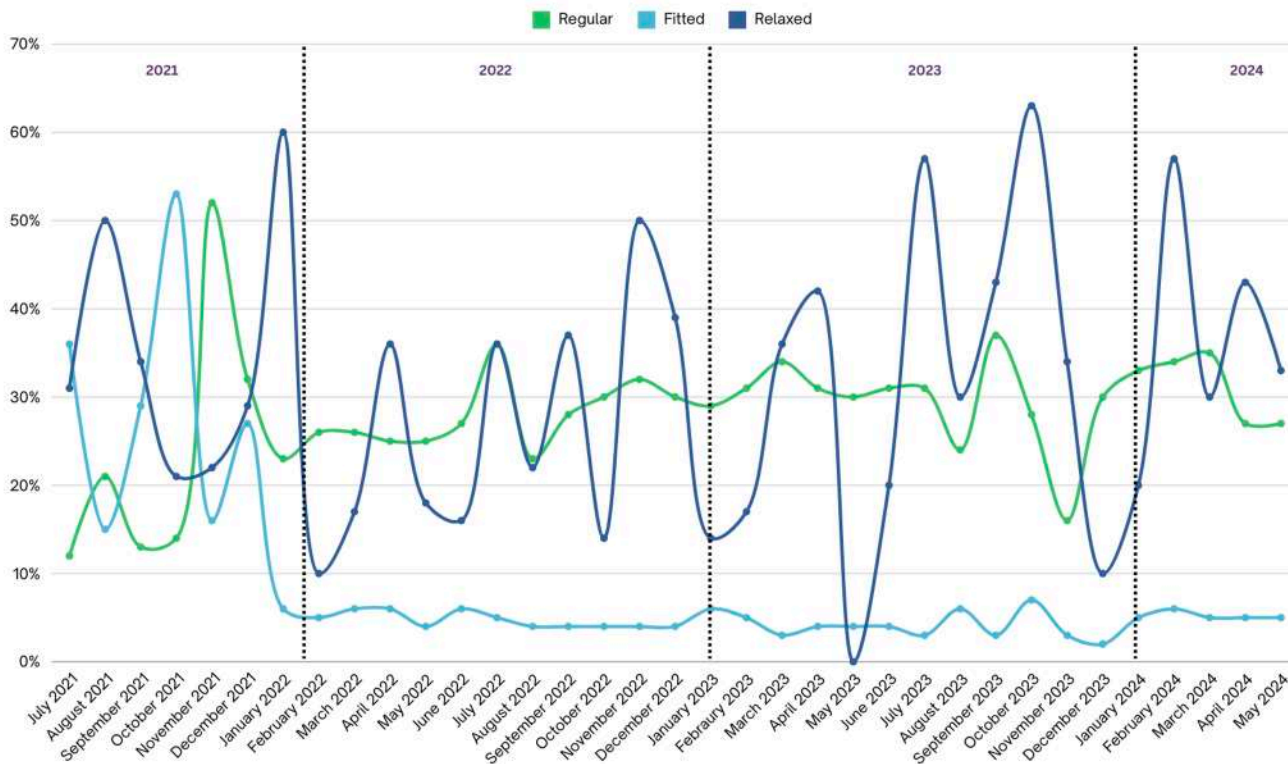
One also observes a juxtaposition with near equal traction gained by both the decollete and zero necklines.
