


Insights from DeepVision

The kids' wear segment represented 20% of the market in 2018 and was expected to reach 1.7 trillion INR by 2028. Urbanization and evolving fashion trends drove growth, with the textile sector employing around 10 million people in 2019. India's apparel exports were valued at \$16.7 billion in 2018, but recent declines stemmed from competition with China, Vietnam, and Bangladesh. To adapt, India has focused on new markets like Hong Kong, Japan, and South Africa. - as reported by Statistica






ATTRIBUTE POPULARITY FROM JULY 2024 - NOV 2024



Reversible pieces like sequin jackets, shimmer cardigans, and puffer vests offer versatility and extend wearability. Subtle metallic accents in trims, buttons, and stitching add a touch of glamour without being overpowering.
